You can print the blank application and fill it out by hand or fill it out in the PDF form, then print. • Insert the completed application into an envelope and mail to State Board of Elections, 140 Walnut Street Frankfort, KY 40601 OR your county clerk (listed below). • Your county clerk will send you an acknowledgement card verifying your registration or inform you of a problem with your registration.

Other Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You must be a citizen of the US and be 18 year old by election day to apply. • Kentucky has closed party primary elections, which means you must register as a Democrat or Republican to vote in that party's primary election. If you select "Other" as your party registration, you are eligible to vote in nonpartisan city and judicial primary elections ONLY. All eligible registered voters may vote for any candidate regardless of party registration in general or special elections. Only persons timely registered to vote shall have the right to vote. • You can use the form to: register to vote, change your name, change your address, register with a party or change parties. • You can check your voter registration status at the Voter Information Center (VIC)... https://cdcbp.ky.gov/VICWeb/index.jsp. VIC includes the address of your voting precinct, a map with driving directions, and your current party registration. • Your post office or library may have additional information or applications.
